Event info

Poison Ivy	<p>There is poison ivy in the Ganaraska forest. The trails are clear but off trail there is plenty of poison ivy. We recommend if you have long socks or trail pants to wear those to be safe and stay on the trails at all times.</p>
Location 	<p>Venue/ Millbrook Agricultural Fairgrounds</p> <p>Parking: 13 Frederick St Millbrook, Ontario L0A 1G0</p> <p>Trails: Millbrook Valley Trails</p> <p>Date: October 2nd, 2022</p>
Format	<p>Enduro races are composed of multiple timed stages, predominantly downhill, over the course of an adventurous ride. The premise is that it mimics a group ride where you ride together with your friends to the stages and then race each other down a trail, regroup at the bottom and repeat.</p> <p>Racer will follow the mark trails to the start of each stage where timing will start. At the end of the stage the timing stops and riders work their way to the next stage, this is the “transition” and is not timed.</p> <p>The trails mostly have a sandy base (this does vary at times) and include mostly natural technical features that will have an indicated B-line option. Their claim to fame is the extremely well built jumps and lips built right into the flow of the trail.</p> <p>Riders have to be self-sufficient, there is no tech zone along the course to repair any mechanicals or get outside support. Please carry what you need for the day.</p> <p>This year’s format will be different as we do not have access to the Ganaraska forest for the enduro, due to all the damage from the May wind storm. We will only be using the Millbrook Valley Trails and so to make up for the smaller amount of trails available we will be having a 2 part Enduro. We will have a morning and afternoon course, separated with a lunch break in the middle. We will have a cash BBQ (\$5) on site for riders to get food. There will be 3 stages per course, with slight variations to the repeated stages, see course map below.</p>

<p>Food Station Sponsored by Bloomfield Bicycle Co.</p> 	<p>This year we will be having a BBQ lunch available to all racers! When you come back from your morning stages you will be greeted by the awesome smell of Burgers and Hot dogs being grilled up for you! There will also be snacks and drinks available to be able to load up for the afternoon stages. Bloomfield will be supporting the BBQ and feed zone once again this year.</p> <p>The BBQ will cost \$5, please bring cash</p> <p>Riders will be required to carry enough water and food to sustain themselves on course.</p> <p>In addition to the BBQ there will be some cool sponsor tents set up for you to see and chat with.</p> <p>We will also have the Peterborough Axe Throwing club on site with an awesome set up for you to try some axe throwing with your friends!</p>
<p>Pre-riding</p>	<p>There is no official organized preride. Trail are open to the public therefore riders may preride at any time prior to the event.</p> <p>Parking for preride is either at the Elgar St. parking lot or the</p>

Glamorgan trail head.

Stages will not be marked until Friday September 30th. The full course will be marked on Saturday Oct. 1st.

Stage 4: Trench Town

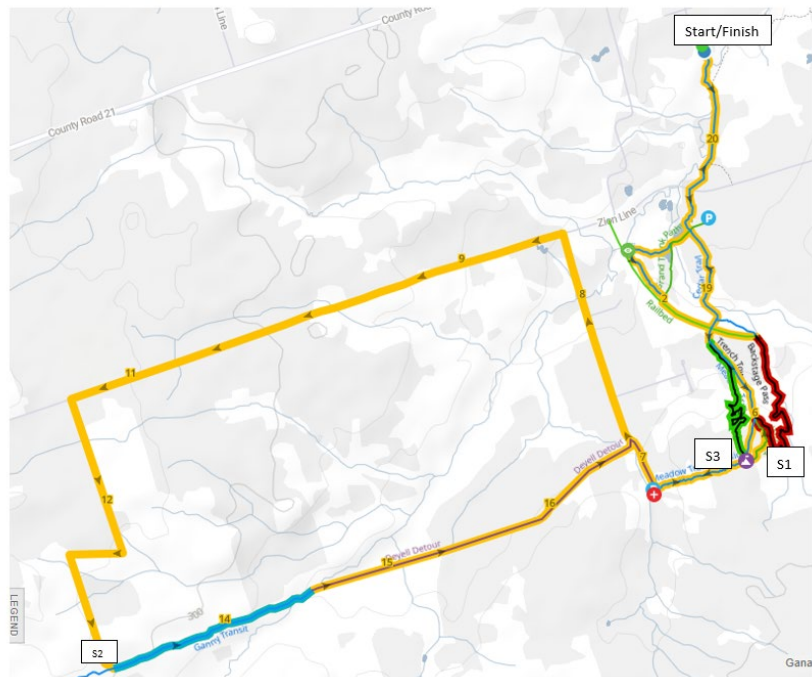
Stage 5: Upper GT

Stage 6: The Itch -> Backstage Pass -> Roots Revival -> cedar trail

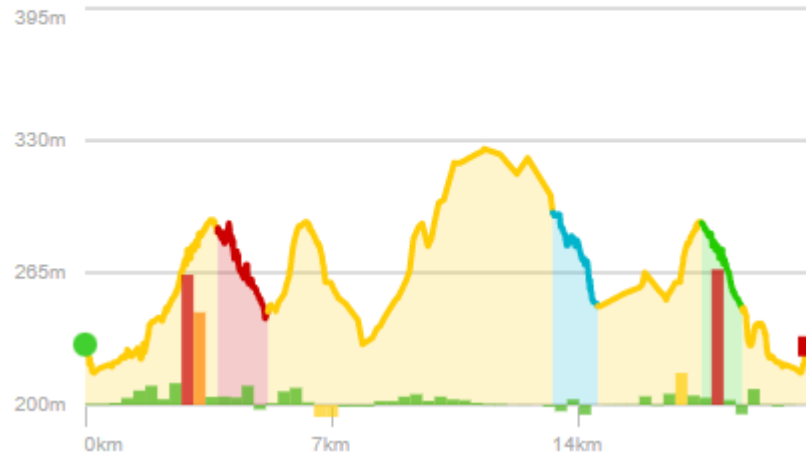

If we are able to get live timing we will do so and inform you at the start of the race. Results will be posted at webscorer.com, link below, and results will be posted after the race is complete.</p> <p>Ganny Enduro (webscorer.com)</p> <p>If a racer is unable to complete a stage for some reason (mechanical, etc) they will be awarded the same time as the slowest racer for that stage. If you stop to help a rider who</p>

<p>Schedule</p>	<p>8am-9:45am - Racers sign in and package pick up</p> <p>9:45am-10am - Morning Course Racer pre race briefing</p> <p>10am: All racers begin to depart in groups of 10 spaced 5 mins apart to avoid congestion in the trails and at the stage 1 start.</p> <p>12pm-1:30pm - BBQ lunch</p> <p>1:30 - Afternoon Course racers begin to depart in groups of 10 spaced 5 mins apart to avoid congestion in the trails and at the stage 1 start.</p>

	<p>4pm - Race cut-off. Riders must be back by this time and have completed the final stage.</p> <p>4:30pm - Award/ Podium</p>
<p>Refund Policy</p>	<p>If the Enduro is canceled for any reason, we will fully refund fees less a small admin fee to cover online and credit processing fees.</p> <p>In the event of an “Act of God” participants will NOT be entitled to any form of refund (this includes severe rain, adverse weather conditions, etc.).</p> <p>Registrations cannot be canceled.</p>
<p>Emergency/ First Aid</p> 	<p>We will have 2 first aid trained volunteers on site to administer any first you may require. At the start of the event they will both be located near registration. During the race we will have one posted at the end of elgar drive and the other will be at registration.
